The Value of Certified Peer Specialists

Peer support encompasses a range of activities and interactions between people who share similar experiences of being diagnosed with mental health conditions, substance use disorders, or both. This mutuality between a peer support specialist and person in/or seeking recovery promotes connection and inspires HOPE. Peer support offers a level of acceptance, understanding, and validation not found in other professional relationships. By peers sharing their own lived experience and practical guidance, peer support specialists help individuals they work with develop their own personal goals, create strategies for self-empowerment, and assist and encourage them to take concrete steps towards building fulfilling, self-determined lives.

There are many studies that validate the effectiveness of peer support. Research has proven that peer support helps improve individual recovery outcomes. Now more than ever, there is a great emphasis on recovery from mental illness and substance use disorders. Our goal is to help create a statewide network of certified peers where their unique skills are utilized, and their lived experience valued.
