What we do

\$50,000 in scholarships

ARCHway's primary vehicle for awarding these grants is the ARCHway HOPE Fund. So far in 2020 ARCHway has awarded **70** grants to recovery housing providers, treatment providers, and additional recovery community supports. At least **40** of these grants went to recovery housing.

ARCHway also strives to connect individuals and families to the right resources to initiate a pathway to long-term recovery from substance use disorders. We provide this service **FREE** of charge through our Advocates for HOPE program—peers thriving in recovery and caregivers affected by a loved one's addiction who offer supportive conversation and connection to recovery resources.

ARCHway helps to educate the community about the issues and solutions surrounding alcohol and drug addiction. We do this to spread awareness in the community and to assist individuals and families being directly impacted by addiction.

National Institute of Environmental Health Sciences (NIH) reports:

- **50%** - Nearly half of Americans report coronavirus crisis is negatively impacting their mental health.
- **1,000%** - There was a 1,000% increase in emotional distress reported to emergency hotlines

ARCHway has also seen an increase in need:

- **82** - In 2020, ARCHway received 82 request for financial assistance and overall support.
- Recovery housing providers have reported a need for financial assistance due to residents being laid off and not being able to afford rent, food, cleaning supplies, etc.

COVID-19 has Fueled the Addiction Epidemic

Addiction can ruin lives, devastate families, and steal our loved ones away from us. The physical and emotional pain that accompanies addiction is felt on both the side of the individual with the disease and their family members, and unfortunately, we are only seeing an increase in diagnosis, overdoses, and deaths.

According to preliminary data released by the Missouri Institute for Mental Health (MIMH), the state has seen a 53% increase in opioid-involved deaths in 2020 as compared to 2019. Why the increase?

Many things can play into this increase, but we know one thing for sure, we are seeing a surge in mental health and substance use disorders nation-wide due to COVID-19. According to the [Overdose Detection Mapping Application Program](#) (ODMAP), "There was a 17.59 percent increase in overdoses reported during the post stay-at-home order time period [March 19, 2020 - May 19, 2020]." Isolation in combination with the economic downturn and our current social and political climate only further fuels the need in the recovery community for treatment, recovery housing, and community support.

What can we do about it? Join with ARCHway to knock down barriers to recovery and increase access to care for those affected by these disorders.

The Cost of Recovery



ARCHway HOPE Circle Sponsor: \$10,000 could fund an ARCHway Silver Level HOPE Fund Sponsorship enabling ARCHway to continue to provide scholarships to recovery housing providers, treatment providers, and additional recovery oriented systems of care.

ARCHway Leaders Circle Sponsor: \$5,000 could fund 1 of ARCHway's Annual Giving Campaigns in which ARCHway awards \$5,000 in grants as scholarships to recovery oriented organizations in need.

ARCHway Sponsor: \$2500 could fund ARCHway's Virtual Education and Awareness Events for a year.

Awareness Sponsor: \$1000 could fund Peer Support Services for more than 30 people.

Recovery Sponsor: \$500 could fund an individual's first month at recovery housing. During that month they can get stabilized through treatment, establish new support networks, and find a job or additional funding streams.

Community Sponsor: \$250 could fund food and essential items for a month for an individual, so he/she can focus solely on their recovery.

Health Sponsor: \$100 could fund an individual's bus passes for a month, so they can get to and from treatment and work.
